DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Beverly Hills Cycling Classic: From Milwaukee, take I-94 East toward Chicago. On the North side of Chicago take I-90/94 toward downtown. At Exit 63 take I-57 S and take Exit 355 at 111th St. Turn Right on 111th St., Right on Vincennes Ave., and Left on 107th St.

Metro South Medical Center Blue Island ProAm: From Milwaukee, Take I-94 East toward Chicago. On the North side of Chicago take I-294 along the West side of the city. Exit at 127th Street East. Take 127th Street east to Blue Island, 3 miles. Turn right on Irving Ave. and follow signs to parking in Metra parking lots.

Sherman Health Elgin Cycling Classic: From Milwaukee, Take I-94 East toward Chicago. On the North side of Chicago take I-294S toward Indiana/O'Hare. Take I-90 West and exit southbound on State St/IL 31. Turn Left on Lawrence Ave.

Richton Park Criterium: Take I-94 E toward Chicago/Indiana, take I-294 S toward Indiana/ O'Hare. Merge onto I-80W and take I-57S at Exit 151A. Merge onto Hwy 30 E/Lincoln Hwy at Exit 340A. Turn right on Cicero Ave, left on Sauk Trail, right on Latonia Ln to parking lot.

Arlington Heights Criterium: Take I-94 E toward Chicago/Indiana, take I-294 S toward Indiana/ O'Hare. Take I-90 West and exit on northbound Arlington Hts. Rd. Turn Left on South St. and Right on Vail Ave.

Ray Basso Bensenville Criterium: From Milwaukee, take I-94 toward Chicago/Indiana, take I-294 S toward Indiana/O'Hare, take the IL-19 W/ Irving Park Rd. Exit. Merge onto Irving Park Rd., turn left onto York Rd. Turn left on George St.

Tim Hart DDS/Rainbow Jersey Shorewood Criterium: Take I-43 to the Capitol Drive Dr. Exit (Exit 76). Go toward Lake Michigan (East) and turn left on Oakland Avenue.

Hammer Nutrition Tour of Holy Hill: Take US-45 N (Exit 305 on I-94 towards Fond du Lac). North of Milwaukee, merge onto US-41 N and exit at westbound Hwy 60. Turn left on Kettle Moraine Rd and continue South to Pike Lake Beach parking lot. There is a \$5 parking fee per vehicle on the park grounds.

Schlitz Park - Endeavour Cycling Challenge: *From Downtown:* Take I-43N to Exit 73B (Fond du Lac Ave/Walnut St). Right on Walnut St. to 2nd St. *From North:* Take I-43S to North Ave. Bear left on Halyar St. Turn left on Walnut St. Continue to 2nd St.

NorthShore University Health System Grand Prix of Cycling: From Milwaukee, Take I-94 East toward Chicago. Continue on I-94 when splits from I-294 north of Chicago. Take I-94, (aka Edens Expressway) to Exit 37A, Dempster St. Go east on Dempster 4 miles to Asbury Ave. Turn left on Asbury Ave., proceed five blocks to Church St. Turn right go three blocks on Church St. to Benson Ave. Turn right on Benson Ave. Sherman Plaza parking deck is on the left. Riders must park in the Sherman Plaza parking deck on Benson Ave. between Church and Davis Streets, less than one block from Start/Finish line and registration. Ceiling height in the parking deck requires that bicycles be removed before entering.

Wheel & Sprocket Whitnall Park Road Race: Take I-94 E toward Chicago and take the I-43S/I-894W Exit. Take Forest Home Ave. Exit and go west on W. Forest Home Ave./WI-24 W. Turn left on S 92nd St. and turn right at Park entrance. There is a \$4.50 fee per person for parking in the Botanical Garden lot. Small building behind stage is available as changing room.

Columbia St. Mary's Urgent Care Cedarburg Cycling Classic: Take I-43 N to Exit 92 (Washington St./Hwy 60). Turn left at top of ramp. Continue to Sheboygan Rd., turn Left. Left at Washington Ave., quick right on Bridge Rd. **Riders** turn Left on Evergreen Blvd., park in school parking lot. **NOTE:** Pioneer Rd/Hwy C is closed for construction.

AltoLab Lake Front Road Race: At the downtown interchange, take I-794 E to the Lake Front Exit (Lincoln Memorial Drive). Take a left at the base of exit, going North on Lincoln Memorial Dr. Start/Finish is just north of the Milwaukee Yacht Club at the base of Lafayette Hill Rd.

Racine.org Criterium: Take I-94 E toward Chicago. Exit at Ryan Rd/Hwy 100 and turn Left. Turn Right on Chicago Rd/Hwy 32. Turn Left on Goold St. Turn Right on Main St.

Chase Food Folks & Spokes: Take I-94 E toward Chicago and exit at Highway S (Exit 340). Take Highway S East, continuing as Highway S joins 38th St and Washington Rd. Near downtown you will pass the Washington Park Velodrome on your right. Turn right on Sheridan Rd/Highway 32. Rider parking is at Durkee Elementary School at the corner of 62nd St. and Sheridan Rd.

Great Downer Avenue Bike Race: Take I-43 to the Locust St. Exit and head East on Locust St. towards UWM. Take a right on Downer Ave.

Time Warner Whitefish Bay Classic: Take I-43 to East Silver Spring Dr. Exit (Exit 78). Coming from the South, you will need to take a left at the base of the ramp and an immediate right onto Silver Spring Dr.

• Results are final 15 minutes after posting.

• Prize money is paid out immediately after each race. Prize money not claimed by 12/11/2009 will be forfeit.
